From the Pastor's Study:

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your father who is in heaven." (Matt. 5:14-16)

The above Scripture passage has come to mind frequently in recent days. Our congregation is coping with the recent passing of three men who were loved and respected and served this church in many different capacities. Age, dementia, and cancer may have limited their involvement in recent years, but the sum of each of their lives is so much more than just the last few years. Each man "let their light shine" throughout their lives, and their influences will not be forgotten. I saw something on Facebook, written by a Steven Charleston, that sums it up perfectly: "Your song will not end. The kindness you have shown. The wisdom you have shared. The love you have given. We rejoice that we shared in the lives of those we love, we rejoice that they are fully healed and free from pain, we rejoice that they are in the full glory and presence of our Lord, and we rejoice that we will ultimately be reunited with them.

The lives of fellow Christians such as these remind us of the importance of not just having faith, but living and speaking it daily. Every day we are a living, breathing, walking testimony. What we do and what we say matters. If the Gospel is going to spread throughout our community and into the next generations, it will be through us.
