Heirs According to Promise

We are now solidly into the year of 2021 and we are still in uncertain times. While many of us have found new routines, new ways of living normally, we still live in a time in which the future is uncertain. Of course, the future can never really be known, but in the midst of the ongoing global pandemic and the recent political turmoil that had our entire nation on edge, it feels like we are standing on the precipice of a cliff. In times like these it can be easy to get set into our own tribe, our own group, our own party. We do this for any number of reasons but when things are especially uncertain, we do so for comfort and safety. To know that we are not alone in the challenges we face or the concerns we have for ourselves, our friends, and our families. Yet when we do this, it can be all too easy to begin to push others away. To disregard or fail to listen to those who fall outside of our established norm. That isn't to discredit the feeling of safety one gets from having that tribe, that group, because I think that is important. Yet, we are called to be open and hear those who might believe and behave very differently from us. We do this because although we may draw up such divisions and lines, the kingdom of God has no such divisions.

In one of my favorite passages from scripture we get another glimpse at what the kingdom of God looks like. This passage comes from the book of Galatians in its third chapter. Toward that back half of the book, Paul is describing the purpose of the law and how it is not opposed to the promises of God but it served as a disciplinarian until Christ's arrival so that we could be justified by faith. Then picking up in verse 26 until the end Paul writes "for in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith. As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to the promise." You see, when we become a part of the kingdom, when we are baptized having decided to follow Jesus, to be Christ like, we are brought into the kingdom reality where the things that would have divided us or separated us are put away. A modern reimagining might go like this: there is no longer Republican or Democrat, capitalist or socialist, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. This is the kingdom reality, that regardless of our background, our political beliefs, our origins, our gender, we are all one, together, in Jesus Christ. So, in this time of uncertainty, in this time where things continue to be outside of our normal, let us remember that we are all one community, together in Christ, and to support and love one another. Because since we belong to Christ, we are heirs according to the promise.

Treasurer's Corner

We're probably all glad that 2020 is over! Hopefully, we can all be back together soon. As your treasurer, let me express my deep gratitude for the wonderful support you have continued to give this congregation through a difficult and trying time.

Donations in December were \$39,153.03 and expenses were \$38,033.68. The expenses included our quarterly property/liability insurance premium of \$6,899.25. Our premiums went up 32% this year, primarily due to national/global losses (think floods, hurricanes, tornadoes, California fires, etc.). The mortgage balance is \$184,626.21.


